

EXCISE ABATEMENTS

Excise Bills are determined by the Registry of Motor Vehicles!!!

EXCISE BILLS FOLLOW THE PLATE, NOT THE CAR.

No excise bill may be reduced to less than \$5.00.

No abatement of less than \$5.00 will be granted.

No refund of less than \$5.00 will be made.

Cancelled Plates: Calculated based on the month of cancellation. i.e cancelled on 2-1-2012 customer pays for 2 months.

Transferred Plates: Based on date of transfer. Abate 1st bill from month of transfer. Owner must pay all of 2nd bill.

No longer have car: Owner needs to have a "Plate Return Receipt" or "Lost Plate Affidavit" from the registry. If junked we need documentation showing date and Vin #.

No longer live in Mass: Owner needs to have a "Plate Return Receipt" and a copy of the new registration showing new state and date of registration.

No longer live in Millbury: You pay excise to wherever you were living as of January 1st of the year. Owner needs to change info at the Registry and with Insurance Company. You'll need a the Insurance Selection Page to show Principal Place of Garaging.

Never Lived in Millbury: Need Insurance Selection Page to show Principal Place of Garaging.

Excise Values are based on the vehicle's original Manufacture's Suggested Retail Price, not current Market Value or what was paid for the vehicle.

Excise Values are determined as follows:

50% - The year preceding the designated year of manufacture.

90% - In the year of manufacture.

60% - In the second year.

40% - In the third year.

25% - In the fourth year.

10% - In the fifth and remaining years of the vehicle's life.
