### ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

#### Section. 10-1. Public Administration Research Collection.

- a. There is hereby established, and there shall hereafter be maintained a public administration research collection at the Town's Public Library, the same to be under the supervision of the Library Trustees, for the use of the Town officers and committees, civic organizations and individual citizens of the Town engaged in research in matters pertaining to governmental and social problems, particularly as they relate to the Town. To the extent that the Town Clerk's office and the library department facilities permit, they shall assist the Town Meeting and any committee thereof in all matters requiring statistical research or fact finding in connection with studies ordered by the Town Meeting.
- b. The Chairman of each temporary study committee established by the Town Meeting shall upon termination of the existence and the work of the committee, deposit with the Town Clerk the working papers and other material (including meeting notes and minutes, preliminary drawings) gathered or compiled by the Committee in the course of its work. The original material shall remain in the Town Clerk's office and copies of such shall be suitably prepared and reproduced for deposit with the Library Trustees to be placed in the Public Administration Collection, subject to the approval of the Town Clerk and the requirements of chapter 66 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth, the Library Trustees may destroy so much of such working papers and materials as has no substantial value; and the balance shall be deposited in the Public Administration Research Collection.
- c. The Town Clerk shall furnish the Town Library Trustees with at least two (2) copies of every publication issued by the Town and distributed through the Town Clerk's office; and any town Department, Board, Commission or Committees publishing a report not so distributed shall file at least two (2) copies thereof with the Town Library Trustees for deposit in the Public Administration Research Collection.
