

Section. 10-2. Public Administration Research Collection- Building Committee Working Papers.

- a. Except as the laws of the Commonwealth may otherwise require, the chairman of each building committee, the Chairman's designated representative, shall upon the termination of the existence and work of the committee:
 1. Provide the Town department which is to operate and maintain the building with a complete, corrected final set of plans of the finished structure, and shall relinquish to such department all papers guaranteeing the structure or any feature thereof, material used therein, or work done thereon, and
 2. Relinquish the remaining papers of such committee to the Town Clerk for the purpose specified In Section 10-1 (a), including therewith an inventory indicating what papers, materials and records were deposited with the Town department specified.
- b. Subject to the approval of the Town Clerk and the requirements of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, the Town Library Trustees may destroy so much of the material relinquished to the Library as has no substantial value; and the balance of such material shall be deposited in the Public Administration Research Collection.
