

ARTICLE II. BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section. 10-16. Composition; Terms.

The Board of Trustees of the Town Library shall consist of seven (7) persons to be chosen by town by ballot, for terms of three (3) years each, so arranged that for two years, two (2) trustees are elected annually, and three (3) trustees are elected at the next annual election. (Bylaws, Art. 6, § 1, 11-12-40; Bylaws Art. 88, 5-4-74; Art. 34, 5-3-05)

Section. 10-17. Powers and Duties.

The Board of Library Trustees shall:

- a. Have the full charge and control of the Town Library and
- b. Have the power to appoint a Librarian and one or more Assistant Librarians and fix the salary of the same
- c. Have approval of bills presented for payment from all appropriations voted by the town for the care of improvement of the library.

Section. 10-19. Responsibilities

The Board of Trustees shall have those responsibilities provided by General. Laws, Ch. 78, Section 7-13 and the Bylaws of the Town of Millbury as regards that custody and management of the Library, and shall be responsible for all property owned by the Town pertaining to the Library. The Board shall approve bills for payment from all appropriations voted by the Town for the care and improvement of the Library. It shall be responsible for all monies appropriated by the Town for the Library and all money or property received by the Town by gift or bequest for the Library. The Board may impose and collect fines not exceeding five cents (\$.05) per day for the book or other item, kept in violation of the Library's rules. (Bylaws, Art. 6, § 1, 11-12-40; Art. 88, 5-4-74; Art. 44, 5-1-01)
