

- c. Simulated sport games, e.g., baseball, hockey, etc.
- d. Coin-operated skee ball games,
- e. Coin-operated computer games, etc.,
- f. Coin-operated simulated driving and/or racing games, and
- g. Coin-operated video games,

shall be limited to a total of three (3) in any one (1) business establishment as described in the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 140, Section 181, in the Town of Millbury.

The limitation on the number of coin-operated amusement devices in a business shall not apply to any business establishment devoted primarily to providing "family-type amusement" to the public and conducted on a site containing at least five (5) continuous acres of area. For the purpose of this bylaw, a business establishment providing "family-type amusement" shall mean a business offering separate recreational facilities for children and adults and not serving alcoholic beverages.

No such establishment shall be operated without the license from the Board of Selectmen required by the Massachusetts General Laws.
