ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Sections. 13-1 to 13-15. Reserved.

ARTICLE II. DEPARTMENT**

Section. 13-16. Composition.

There shall be a police department consisting of a chief, to be appointed by the board of selectmen, and such additional members as the Board of Selectmen shall deem necessary for a proper enforcement of the laws.

Section. 13-17. Chief Responsible for Actions of Associate Members.

The Chief of Police shall be responsible to the Board of Selectmen for the actions of the Associate Members in the Police Department.

Section. 13-18. Annual Report of Chief.

The Annual Report of the Chief of Police shall contain:

a. A tabulated report of the number of arrests during the year showing the cause of such arrest.
