

Section. 14-8. Acceptance of Streets.

Streets shall be laid out and accepted by the Town only as provided in Chapter 82, Sections 21 through 24, of the General Laws, and Chapter 41, Section 81 of the General Laws, as amended. No petition for acceptance shall be acted on at the Annual Town Meeting unless submitted to the Board of Selectmen by October 30. The Town will provide necessary engineering services for petitioned streets, provided that full release of fee in the street and for all necessary appurtenant easements is previously assured, and provided that a complete list of names and addresses of all abutters is furnished. The Town shall accept no ways created subsequent to March 1956, unless the requirements of the subdivision control law have been met for such ways. (Bylaws, Art. 14, § 7,1-31-71; Art. 63, 4-7-79)

Editor's Note -The provisions set forth herein as § 14-8, which derived from General Bylaws of Jan. 31, 1971, Art. 14, § 7, were omitted from the original codification. At the request of the Town, such provisions were included herein as part of Supp. No.1. At the Annual Town Meeting of April 7, 1979, the Town voted unanimously to amend the Millbury Code by adding a new § 14- 7 which reenacted the provisions contained in General Bylaws of January 31, 1971, Art. 14, § 7, and included herein as § 14-8.

Section. 14-9 Snow Removal.

No person shall move snow or ice from private property onto the traveled portion of a public way or sidewalk so as to impede or obstruct the use of such public way or sidewalk or so as to create a hazard or unsafe condition on such a public way or sidewalk. "Whoever violates this section shall be subject to a penalty of up to Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) per violation." (Bylaws, Art.36, 5-7-96).

Section. 14-10. Restriction of Hours on Town Common.

No person shall use, or be present upon, the property known as the T own Common between the hours of 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. daily. Notwithstanding the preceding restriction, the Park Commissioners may authorize the use of the Town Common during these hours, in accordance with rules or regulations promulgated by the Park Commissioners, pursuant to M.G.L. C. 45, Sec. 5. (Bylaws, Art. 39, 5-7-96).

Section.14-11. Temporary Repairs of Private Ways.

Section. 14-11-1. Authorization of Temporary Repairs.

The Town of Millbury may make temporary repairs on private ways which have been opened to public use for a period of six (6) years or more, provided that the repairs are for the protection of the health and safety of the general public using such roads.
