STREETS, SIDEWAKS AND PUBLIC PLACES*

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Section. 14-1. Coasting.

No person shall coast upon or across any sidewalk or street in the Town except at such time and in such places as may be from time to time designated by the Board of Selectmen. (Bylaws, Art. 14, § 2, 11-12-40)

Section. 14-2. Parade Permit.

No person shall form or conduct any parade in any street, sidewalk or public way within the Town without a written permit signed by the Board of Selectmen. (Bylaws, Art. 14, § 8, 11-12-40)

Section. 14-3. Amusement Products.

(a) General

1. Statement: The Town of Millbury values the life, well being and public safety of its residents as well as the physical beauty of the community and the need to reduce litter and non-degradable wastes.

2. Purpose: The purpose of this provision is to regulate the sale, possession and use of certain amusement products in public areas.

3. Products: Products commonly known as Silly String, Instant Smoke, Bomb Bag and other similar products sold for amusement in an aerosol can and knowingly used as a flammable objectionable product, have been sold and used in the community and have resulted in:
