

- (f) Injunction: In addition to all other remedies and penalties provided by this bylaw, the Town may bring suit in a court of competent jurisdiction to seek an injunction or other appropriate relief to halt any violation of this ordinance. Such action may include seeking a temporary restraining order or temporary injunction and other appropriate temporary relief and costs of suits including attorneys fee. Nothing in this ordinance shall be deemed to restrict a suit for damages on behalf of the Town or on behalf of any other person or entity.

- (g) Penalty: Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an infraction and shall pay a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for a first offense and Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for each and every subsequent offense. (Bylaws Art. 15, 5-6-97)
