

- e. No person or persons, shall park, for a period longer than sixty (60) minutes where not otherwise prohibited between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., any truck, tractor, bus or trailer with a five-ton registered gross weight or over, upon any highway, street, alley, public way or public place in the town.

No person or persons shall park any trailer or semitrailer upon any highway, street, alley, public way or public place, unless the trailer or semitrailer is, at all times while so parked, attached to a vehicle capable of moving the trailer or semitrailer in a normal manner upon the highway, street, alley, public way or public place.

This Subsection (e) shall not apply to trucks, tractors, buses or trailers of five-ton registered gross weight or over when in the process of being loaded or unloaded, nor shall it apply to any of the aforementioned vehicles which are disabled in such a manner to such an extent that it is impossible to avoid stopping and temporarily leaving the disabled vehicle on that portion of the highway, street, alley, public way or public place, ordinarily used for vehicular parking.

Section. 15-4. Fire Apparatus Responding to Call.

No person shall fail to yield the right-of-way to any piece of fire apparatus responding to a call, upon signal.

Section. 15-5. Handicapped Parking.

a. Any person or body that has lawful control of a public or private way or of improved or enclosed property used as off-street parking areas for business, shopping malls, theaters, auditoriums, sporting or recreational facilities, cultural centers, residential dwellings, or for any other place where the public has a right of access as invitees or licensees, shall be required to reserve parking spaces in said off-street parking areas for any vehicle owned and operated by a disabled veteran or handicapped person whose vehicle bears the distinguishing license plate “the words” or distinguishing placard” authorized by General Laws, Chapter 90, Section 2, according to the following formula:

If the number of parking spaces in any such area is more than fifteen (15) but not more than twenty-five (25), one (1) parking space; more than twenty-five (25) but not more than forty (40), five (5) per cent of such spaces but not less than two (2); more than forty (40) but not more than one hundred (100), four (4) percent of such spaces
