**ARTICLE V -A. INDIVIDUAL HEALTH
INSURANCE CONTRACTS**

Section. 2-116. Authority.

Pursuant to the Second Article of Amendment to the Massachusetts Constitution and Chapter 43B of the General Laws, the Town of Millbury is hereby empowered to pay for, in whole or in part, individual or family health care insurance coverage and benefits for persons unable to be covered by group health plans and health maintenance organization plans offered by the Town, in accordance with this article. (Bylaws of 9-24-91, Art. 4, § 1)

Section. 2-117. Reimbursement for Town Employees and Retirees.

The Board of Selectmen is hereby authorized to approve reimbursement by the Town to employees and retirees of the Town who reside outside the service area of any health maintenance organization plan offered by the Town for reasonable expenses incurred by such persons in the purchasing of individual or family health insurance contracts, or under such contracts, in such amounts and in such manner and under such conditions as the Board of Selectmen deem to be in the interest of the Town, subject to availability of funds. (Bylaws of 9-24-91, Art. 4, § 2)

Section. 2-118. Reimbursement for School Department Employees.

The School Committee is hereby authorized to approve reimbursement by the Town to School Department Employees who reside outside the service area of any health maintenance organization plan offered by the Town for reasonable expenses incurred by such persons in the purchasing of individual or family health insurance contracts, or under such contracts, in such amounts and in such manner and under such conditions as the School Committee deems to be in the interest of the Town, subject to the availability of funds. The School Committee may delegate its authority under this section to the Board of Selectmen. (Bylaws of 9-24-91, Art. 4, § 3)

Section. 2-119. Rules and Regulations.

The Board of Selectmen shall have the authority to issue rules and regulations concerning the carrying out of this Article, including, but not limited to the type and coverage of any insurance plans to be subject to reimbursement by the Town and the amount of such reimbursement. (Bylaws of 9-24-91, Art. 4, § 4)

Section. 2-120. Residents in Service Area.
