ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Section. 4-1. Permits Required for Keeping of Swine.

No person shall keep within the limits of this Town, in any building, or on any premises of which he may be the owner, lessee, tenant or occupant, any swine without a permit from the Board of Health. All such permits expire annually on December thirty-first and may be revoked by the board of health at any time for cause. (Bylaws, Art. 7 A, § 2, 3-8-52)

Section. 4-2. Sanitation Requirements for Livestock Buildings.

(a) The owners or persons in control of any building or premises, in which cows, goats, live fowl or swine are kept, shall keep the buildings clean and free from decaying food, filth, dirt and stagnant water. The buildings and pens shall be whitewashed or disinfected and put in such condition as may be ordered by the Board of Health.

(b) The owner or other persons having control of any existing building or buildings hereafter erected or converted into premises to keep swine or other livestock shall keep their barns, stables, and yards clean, and shall provide a pit constructed of cement or other suitable material for the containment of manure and other refuse matter. When a public sewer is accessible, the Board of Health will decide as to the advisability of connecting such building with such public sewer. (Gen. Bylaws, Art. 7 A, §§ 3, 4, 3-8-52)
