

Section. 4-26. Responsibilities of the Dog Officer.

(a) It shall be the duty of the Dog Officer to investigate complaints concerning any dogs which are alleged to be in violation of Town Bylaws and to apprehend any dog found by him or her to be a public nuisance and to impound such dog in a suitable place or to order the owner thereof to restrain such dog.

(b) It shall be the responsibility of the Dog Officer to maintain proper records as required by the Town of Millbury.

(c) The Town Manager shall authorize the Dog Officer, or acting Dog Officer, to issue citations and penalties and enforce established regulations as found in section 4-25 of these Bylaws.

(d) The Dog Officer, appointed by the Town Manager in May of each year, shall act in accordance with the General Laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Chapter 140, Sections 136A To 175.
