

Section. 5-3. Permit Fees.

A schedule of fees for permits as authorized under Section 118.0 of the Basic Code shall be as established and revised from time to time by the Board of Selectmen. (Bylaws, Art. 16, § 2, 5-3-75)

Section. 5-4. Fire Districts.

(a) No Fire District No.1 is established.

(b) Fire District No.2, as referred to at section 301.2 of the Basic Code shall comprise all areas in "Business A or B II or "Industrial A or B II districts as established in the Millbury Zoning Bylaw as most recently amended.

(c) All other areas not included in Fire Districts Nos. 1 and 2 are designated as II Outside Fire Limits." (Bylaws, Art. 16, § 3,5-3-75)

Section. 5-24. Appointment; Duties.

The Town Manager shall appoint an inspector of gas piping and gas appliances for the term of one year whose duty shall be the enforcement of the rules and regulations adopted by the State Board established under Chapter 25 Section 12H, General Laws of Massachusetts.
