

Chapter 7

GARBAGE, TRASH AND REFUSE*

- Article. I. In General, §§ 7-1 to 7-15
Article. II. Private Collectors, §§ 7-1 to 7-21

ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL

Section. 7-1. Reserved.

Editor's note -Section 7-1, which pertained to frequency of garbage collections, was repealed by Art. 31 adopted at the Annual Town Meeting of April 4, 1981. The repealed provision derived from General Bylaws, Art. 7A, § 5, enacted on March 8, 1952.

Section. 7-2. Vehicles Transporting Rubbish.

All rubbish being transported to the Riverlin Street Transfer Station over any public way in the Town shall be secured by a canvas covering or other suitable means designed to prevent the escape of litter from the transporting vehicle. (Bylaws, Art. 7B, § 1, 3-10-63)

Section. 7-3. Resident Vehicle Stickers.

No vehicle shall be permitted to enter the Riverlin Street Transfer Station for the purpose of dumping rubbish unless it carries an official resident sticker as issued by the Town Clerk or Board of Health. (Bylaws, Art. 12, 12-7-81, Art. 80, 5-7-96).

Section. 7-4. Discarding of Solid Waste.

No person shall discard or cause to be discarded in the Town of Millbury any solid waste brought from without the limits of the Town of Millbury. (Bylaws, Art. 7B, § 3, 3-10-63; Art 66, 6-6-89)
