Section. 7-19. Expiration, Renewal.

All permits required by section 7-16 shall expire December thirty-first of the year in which they are issued, but may be renewed annually. (Bylaws, Art. 7A, § 1, 3-8-52)

Section. 7-20. Compliance with Board of Health Rules.

No person shall remove or transport garbage, offal or other offensive material through any public street, court, lane or way except in accordance with such reasonable rules and regulations as may be established by the Board of Health. (Bylaws, Art. 7 A, § 1, 3-8-52)

Section. 7-21. Vehicles to be Watertight, Securely Covered.

Carts or vehicles used for transporting offensive material shall be watertight and shall be securely covered with a wood, iron or canvas cover. (Bylaws, Art. 7A, § 1, 3-8-52)
