

1. The environmental surveillance program shall include a plan for the systematic monitoring of waste to ensure that RDNA molecules shall not be released into the environment or exposed to persons.
2. The environmental surveillance program shall include a plan to train representatives or consultants of the Millbury Board of Health, the Millbury Fire Department, and the Millbury Police Department in the procedures to be used in the event of an emergency.
3. Any release into the environment or exposure to persons of RDNA, or any significant problems with or violations of the NIH Guidelines of these regulations, or any significant research-related accidents or illnesses, shall be immediately reported to the Millbury Police Department, Millbury Fire Department, and the Millbury Board of Health, or their designee.

Section 8. Penalties.

Any person or institution that violates any provision of this bylaw shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) for each separate violation. Each day or portion thereof during which such violation(s) continues shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 9. Enforcement.

Enforcement of this Bylaw shall be the duty of the Board of Health. The Board of Health may also deem any violation of this by-law to be a nuisance pursuant to General Laws C. III and may take such actions as it deems proper. In addition to any other penalties set forth herein, the Board of Health, after notice to the permittee and an opportunity for the permittee to be heard, may revoke, in whole or in part, any permit granted hereunder if it finds that the permittee has violated any of the provisions of this Bylaw.
