**Programs are being paid for by the Friends of the Millbury Public Library, Millbury Cultural Council and Mary B. Grogan.**

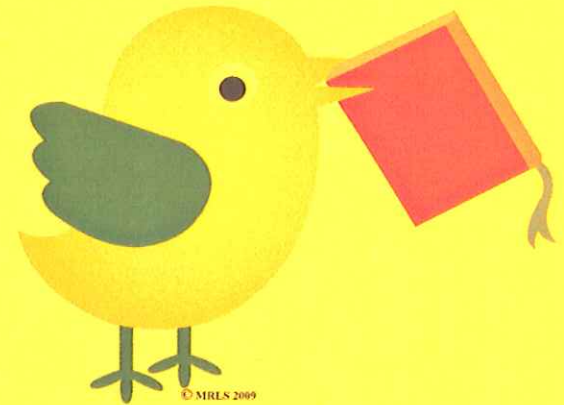
## Reading Program Summer Reading Club
