EMERGENCY ORDER

In addition to the State of Emergency declared by the Governor, the Board of Health of the Town of Millbury, pursuant to its authority in matters of public health, issues the following Emergency Order to preserve public services and to protect public health by reducing the risk of exposure to the COVID-19 virus, thus limiting the spread of said virus.

Effective, immediately, persons shall not enter any town building or facility who are:

- Persons who have been diagnosed with, or have had contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with the coronavirus;
- Persons with apparent symptoms of coronavirus, such as fever, severe cough, or shortness of breath;
- Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine, or who reside with anyone who has been asked to self-quarantine;
- Persons who have had close contact with anyone who has been asked to self-quarantine.

These restrictions are temporary, but will remain in place until lifted by the Board of Health
