**7:00 PM Guest Presentation Peter Peloquin CMRPC Assistant Planner
Hazard Mitigation FEMA Update**

Peter spoke about Pre-storm Measures. Identified the top hazards from a public survey as being snow, thunder storms, & flooding. Also he touched upon improving preparedness and response time. Once adopted it is good for 5 years and then the town will be eligible for more grants.

7:27 PM Citizens Speak- Keith Caruso, DPW Supervisor wanted to ask the public to seek an alternate route as they will be grinding on McCracken Rd Thursday and Friday, also there will be a list of roads for the crack sealing on our website. He explained it has taken so long on McCracken because of ledge. Bidding for line painting will be going out so looking at approx. July 1. Broadmeadow Brook collapsed so they made the repair and did not need the temporary bridge. Weston & Sampson are working on this project. Mr Marciello stated we are still on schedule as we are very early in the season.

Bruce Devault of 14 Forrest Dr mentioned his neighborhood was paved last year and now what was a trickling brook turned into a river. He thinks it may be coming from the new development up the hill. Keith said he was just up there 4-5 hours ago looking at the situation and it is bad. There are three catch basins but with the amount of water they can't keep up. He also went up to Jessica J and walked the property with the builder. There is a retention pond and a spillway pipe. Mr Marciello asked for Weston & Sampson to take a look and see if they can come up with a way to divert the water.

7:46 PM Shaw Building Project Update-Selectman Despres is on the Shaw School Building Committee and they meet every other week. The design has been accepted in theory. They have 5 working groups that they are broken into. They are hoping the new building will be open in 2023 and will have grades 3-6 attend. All meeting are open to the public and they are seeking public input. Once the new building is done the old one will be torn down and removed and then the fields will be constructed.

7:51 PM Re-appoint Board of Fire Engineers

Motion made by Selectman Despres to appoint Richard Hamilton to serve on the Board of Fire Engineers as Fire Chief and as Forest Fire Warden, appoint Brian Gasco, David Rudge, Robert Silver Jr, and Steven Piscitelli as Assnt Chief to serve on the Board of Fire Engineers. 2nd by Selectman Naff

8:01 PM Town Manager Report

Mr. Marciello stated Viewpoint is having many technical issues with the BOH platform after speaking with Mr Vanni we decided to hold off until all the technical bugs are worked out and we are able to work with a more stable system. The webpage will go Live on 5/7/19 the hold up has been on the vendor’s side. Per Mr. Caruso’s update will start the paving program on McCracken next week...weather permitting. Re: the municipal lot the signs are in and now we are just waiting for the poles to come in. Selectman McKenna asked for the Quarterly update. Selectman Naff asked about Broadmeadow Bridge. Mr Marciello responded that all the numbers are based on calculations vs bids and we may be able to do more. Cleargov is a financial tool but but now they have an additional feature where you can put a project in and then follow along and see where the overruns are, benchmarks, and manipulate the system. The Boards said that sounded great and they liked the transparency. Mr Marciello also stated it was something that he did budget for.
