The following items are **required** when applying for a solid fuel burning appliance permit (wood, pellet, gas):

- *Copy of instruction manual showing clearances to combustibles.
- *Copy of instruction manual showing venting information.
- *Millbury solid fuel burning application (completely filled out).
- *Check made out to 'Town of Millbury'.
- *Massachusetts workers' compensation affidavit.
- *Copy of installers' liability insurance certificate.
- *Copy of installers' Construction Supervisors License.
- *Copy of installers' Home Improvement Contractor Registration.

****Homeowners performing their own work will not have access to the guarantee fund under the Home Improvement Contractor Program.**

Incomplete submissions will be rejected.

Final inspections shall be requested in writing by the PERMIT HOLDER.

Upon final inspection, the following are required:

- *Carbon monoxide and smoke detectors
- *Fire extinguisher
- *Steel equipment for ash removal
- *Homeowners' copy of installation manual
