ITEM ONE - CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Picard called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m.

Present: Gil Picard, Marcia Landry, Andrea Paquette, Ken Bedard, JoAnne Holahan, Pieter de Jong

Absent: Randy Mogren

ITEM TWO - APPROVAL OF MINUTES

No meeting minutes pending approval at this time.

ITEM THREE – NEW BUSINESS

- JoAnne Holahan was present to discuss development of a Nature Trail. Also present on her behalf were Ken Bedard & Pieter de Jong. She explained, as a former school teacher, while working with her students regarding environmental interests, she came to know George D'Auteuil, Sr. and his dedication to similar interests in the Town. He in turn invited her students to do a special project presentation before the Board of Selectmen at the time, which they did. JoAnn said she is currently the President of the Blackstone River Watershed Assoc. (BRWA). She admired Mr. D'Auteuil for his contributions to the Town and would like to pursue development of this trail in honor of him. Discussion of proposal ensued. She distributed a proposal for the Cemetery Commission's review. Trail would be located off River St., between the Blackstone River and adjacent cemeteries Central & St. Brigid's. Access to the trail would be through roads in the cemetery, thus she asked for the Commission's thoughts. Marcia Landry commented that parking in the cemetery in order to access the trail would be an issue. Ms. Holahan concurred that a designated parking area outside the cemetery would be necessary & that she would pursue that matter if the Commission is agreeable to the trail development. Marcia Landry approved of the proposal and motioned in favor of allowing proponent to move forward with the project providing they return to the Commission with more information regarding where a parking area and signage would go; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.
- Stuart Mulhane was present to discuss with the Commission the eligibility of those that can, versus, those that cannot purchase a lot in Central Cemetery. He stated his concerns that at the time of death, if someone is not a current resident of Millbury, they cannot be buried in Central Cemetery explaining for example: a Veteran lived in Millbury for years, now lives elsewhere while his family pre-deceased him and is buried in Central Cemetery but now he cannot purchase a lot as a non-resident of Town. Mr. Mulhane stated that most towns allow pre-sales for reasons such as this. He suggested the Commission consider altering the Cemetery Rules & Regulations to address those that have lived in Millbury for a certain number of years be eligible to purchase a cemetery lot. Marcia Landry said the Commission can take this matter under advisement.
- The Clerk prepared the following for the Cemetery Commission's review and signatures:

 Licensed Burial Rights in Central Cemetery issued to Robert & Andrea Anderson

 Marcia Landry motioned to approve as prepared; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained and Commission members signed licenses accordingly.

ITEM FOUR - MONUMENTS

- Re: Request from Pepin Granite Inc. for approval of monument design for *Marquis*: Marcia Landry motioned to approve request; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.
- Re: Request from Whitinsville Monumental Works for approval of monument design for *Lavallee*: Marcia Landry motioned to approve request; Gil Picard seconded; a unanimous vote of approval was obtained.

ITEM FIVE - OLD BUSINESS

- Re: the matter of stump removal at Central Cemetery Marcia Landry asked if we've heard anything from Bob VanMeter, who was supposed to initiate this, as she would like to use FY17 funds to accomplish this. Clerk replied, no. Marcia said she would contact him.
- Re: pinning of double grave section to triple grave lots Marcia reported she spoke to former DPW Director
 and he had said that he discussed doing this project with DPW employee Carl Ward and had planned on
 doing it in-house.

ITEM SIX – OTHER TOPIC

Gil Picard suggested the Commission regulate a limit with regards to the depth that a grave can be dug, in consideration of a recent occurrence at a double-deep gravesite. Marcia Landry commented that that was strictly a necessary exception at the time, does not foresee it happening again and thus, such a rule is not needed.
