Request for Emergency Certificate Form- Millbury #3 Substation on Cross Street-National Grid

Heidi Graf, from BSC Group representing National Grid, submitted this request before the last meeting on October 19th. The Emergency Certificate was signed by Chairman Stead and issued so

emergency work could proceed. Ms. Graf explained where work was taking place, noting this substation runs on two sources of power and one of the overhead lines were down causing the request for emergency work. Tree trimming and cutting work has started, smaller tree materials will be chipped and the larger tree material will be taken off site. Ms. Graf stated that an after-the-fact Notice of Intent will be submitted for the project. A motion was made to issue the Emergency Certificate by Mr. Weagle, seconded by Mr. DiCicco. All in favor, motion approved.

Mr. DiCicco made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:40 p.m., seconded by Mr. Raymond. All in favor, motion approved.
