Public Hearing - Notice of Intent- After the Fact

Massachusetts Electric Company- Service Feeder Lines Emergency Repairs

Cross Street

Heidi Graf, BSC Group, represented the applicant, Massachusetts Electric Company. An Emergency Certificate was signed at the Commission's meeting on October 19th to allow emergency work to occur. An After-the-Fact NOI was submitted to the Commission for work consisting of overhead feeder line repair to Substation #3. Ms. Graf stated that 75 trees have been taken down, which was necessary as the work site must be clear to keep up on all services. The work completed by

10/24/2022. Mr. Stead and Mr. Raymond both asked if the trees removed were necessary. Ms. Graf noted that it was necessary. Mr. Stead asked if there could be trees planted elsewhere in town to replace the loss of so many trees. Ms. Graf was unsure but would look into it. Mr. Raymond asked why they were exempt from tree replacement, to which Ms. Graf noted utility project are exempt from replication under the WPA. A motion to close the Public Hearing was made by Mr. DiCicco, seconded by Mr. Raymond. All in favor, motion approved. A motion to approve the Notice of Intent was made by Mr. Raymond, seconded by Mr. Weagle. All in favor, motion approved.

Other Business:

Notice of upcoming MACC dues for FY24 was received, payment due in June 2023.

The 2023 General Permit for the Lake Singletary Life Jacket Station was received from the Div. of Fisheries and Wildlife.




