- D. Legislative The Medicare blitz is on with Senior Care options all changes need to be made by Dec. 7th.
- E. Senior Center Usage: The 1st Congregational Church of Millbury is using the building on the 17th.
- F. Building Maintenance/Equipment. Ms. O'Connor reported that the Water Company installed new toilets at the Center. This is an effort to conserve water and it was at no cost to the town. Mr. Walinsky asked if it was possible to get a sum pump for the front parking area

when it floods. Ms. O'Connor will check on it. She will contact the new DPW Director to go over our ongoing issues.

Director's Report- Ms. O'Connor reported that she sent in the contract for the EOEA formula grant with both the Town Manager and COA Chairman's signatures. She sent Board member Sarahbeth Persiani and the outreach coordinator to the Dementia conference and we will be working on Millbury becoming a Dementia Friendly community. We are looking for a sponsor for the meeting.

Report on the Friends of the Millbury Seniors, Inc. - Ms. O'Connor reported that they held their annual Fair on the 11th. They are getting ready for the Chain of Lights event. They are accepting donations for the food pantry and will continue to sponsor it.
