Travis Brown, representing Turning Point Engineering, detailed the ANR plan for the Board.

Paul Piktelis made a motion to endorse the plan entitled "Division of Land of 88 South Oxford Road in Millbury, MA", dated November 8, 2022, prepared by Turning Point Engineering, Bruce DeVault seconded, voted unanimously.

Terry Burke Dotson inquired and Mr. Brown stated that there are wetlands on the site and he is not aware of the depth of the pond but that it is likely quite shallow.

Fran DeSimone inquired and Conor McCormack stated that it is named Stone Brook.

Mr. DeSimone inquired and Mr. Brown confirmed that there will be two developable lots on the site.

Ms. Dotson informed the Board about the upcoming CMRPC forum on December 6, 2022.

Ms. Dotson inquired and Mr. Gosselin stated that he is not aware of a scheduled meeting with the Board of Selectmen regarding the municipal parking lot project.
