The Town of Millbury is conducting a town wide sewer rehabilitation project in selected areas within the Town, starting Wednesday, May 18th, 2022. Project area map is shown on the next page for reference. The project is wholly funded through the United States Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) Clean Water Trust Program, administered by Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MA DEP).

The goals of this sewer rehabilitation project are to remove Inflow and Infiltration (I/I) and address structural defects within the Town's sewer system. I/I is excess water that flows into sewer pipes from groundwater and stormwater. By removing this extra flow, the Town will reduce the amount of wastewater it sends to the Upper Blackstone Wastewater Treatment Plant. Other benefits of removing I/I include increasing system capacity and minimizing the potential of sewer back-ups.
