ITEM ONE-CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Gary Nelson called to order the meeting at 4:40 pm.

ITEM TWO - GUEST SPEAKER:

David Perkins owner of 33 Sutton Road came into talk to the board about tying into the town sewer system. Mr. Perkins stated that the Board of Appeals has given him permission to put up two town homes on the property. He is also waiting for approval from the Planning Board for putting up two town homes. I & I Rehab – 1 million was approved. It will go out to bid on February 10, 2022 next bid opening. Phase 5 of I & I will begin soon. The main pump station needs a new jockey pump. Chairman Nelson has spoken to Town Council on this and it will be a 12-year payback. Chairman Nelson spoke about the 146 Water and Sewer project Frank Occhipinti is working on this too. Singletary Arms can either go into the Elm Court Pump Station or directly into the siphon.

Chairman Nelson spoke about 2 warrant articles on the annual town meeting.
