Review and Approval of T2's Amendment no. 12 in the amount not to exceed \$12,740,00 for the additional surveying required by NGrid's utility work. Review and Approval of the MSBA Project Funding Agreement Revision for \$59,083,918.

Mr. Billings reviewed the need for the MSBA Project Funding Agreement (PFA) Revision. He explained that this revision incorporate Fontaine Bros. construction bid. It includes the 2.9 million dollars in savings by lower the town and MSBA obligation and increases the town's contingency fund by one million dollars. The new amount is about 1.4 million dollars less than budget. It is \$59,083,918. It was stated that the full Building Committee and School Committee would need to approve the new PFA amount.
